- Sale Organisers** Melton Mowbray Market Auctioneers, Melton Mowbray Market, Scalford Road, Melton Mowbray, Leics, LE13 1JY. Tel: 01664 562971. The sale will be held under 'National Conditions of Sale' and the NBA Conditions of Sale for cattle.
- Breed Society Event** This is an official sale for all the participating breeds which are responsible for any inspections, weighing, NSP bolus reading, card grading and showing for their breed. Each Society will provide their own stewards, inspectors, judges, cards, rosettes and trophies where applicable. See breed sections for contact addresses and details.
- Disclaimer** The participating Breed Societies, their representatives, judges, inspectors & stewards, Melton Mowbray Market, Grassroots Systems Ltd. and the elected steering committee are acting in good faith on behalf of participating vendors, and accept no responsibility or liability for any death, accident or injury to people, animals or property at the event. Vendors and purchasers are responsible for their animals at all times.
- Catalogue** The catalogue has been prepared in good faith from the information supplied by vendors. - Participating Breeds** Entries have only been accepted from members of participating Breed Societies and for animals registered or eligible for registration in their Herd Books.
- Commission** All lots will be sold in guineas. Commission will be 5% charged to the vendor. There will be a minimum commission per lot of £5 for cattle and £2.50 for pigs. (£2.00 for sheep)
- Levy for Unsold Lots** A levy £2.50 for pigs (£2 per sheep), has been collected with the entry fees and will be retained by the auctioneers for all unsold lots, and refunded to the vendor, by the auctioneers, for all sold lots. The levy for **Unsold Lots with reserves** in the cattle section will be 1/2 commission, to be collected when the passports are returned.
- Society Fees** Breed Society transfer fees or sale levies may be deducted at the market. Please see the relevant breed section in this catalogue.

General Information

Entry Fee Refunds	Entries withdrawn between the closing date and 1st September will be refunded the unsold lot levy. There will be no refunds given for animals withdrawn after 1st Sept.
Cancellation	Should the event be cancelled due to circumstances outside the control of the auctioneers, only the unsold lot levy will be refunded.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Buyers Number	This sale operates a buyers number system. Please register with the auctioneers office prior to the sale where you will be issued with a buyers number.
Statutory Regs.	The event will be carried out in full compliance with the DEFRA and other statutory regulations in place at the time.
Identification	All entries must be tagged in accordance with current DEFRA regulations. Tag numbers must correspond with numbers on passports, pedigree certificates and in the catalogue.
Retags	Must be reported to Grassroots AND the Market
Substitutes Cattle	Substitute lots may be accepted on a like for like basis— accompanied by a relevant veterinary certificate . Substitutes MUST be reported to the auctioneers and to Grassroots, so that the correct animals are transferred and recorded in the market movement records.
Cattle	All entries must be accompanied by a passport , a pedigree certificate and where appropriate a copy of the AI/service certificate.
Weaning	No calves under 7 months of age have been accepted as separate lots. All lots must have been weaned at least 2 weeks prior to the event and in the case of milking cows, must have been properly dried off.
Bulls	All bulls over 10 months must be rung. No person under 16 years of age may have charge of a bull at any time.

Stalling	All animals must be penned or stalled in the space allocated. Cattle in the Halter Section will be halter tied and led into the ring. For Health and Safety reasons all cattle in the Un-Halterd Section will be sold after the completion of the sale of Halter led cattle in each breeds. Vendors are solely responsible for and in charge of their stock at all times whilst on the premises.
Show and Sale	Animals identified with SO are for sale only. Animals identified with S + S are show and sale.
Animal Health	Vendors will be expected to ensure that their animals are in good health and, to the best of their knowledge free from infectious or contagious disease. The entry form included a signed declaration to this effect and entry to the sale therefore carries a warranty of soundness from the vendor. Veterinary surgeons will be on call, in the event of their being required.
Breed Inspection	Some Breed Societies will carry out breed inspections, please see each breed section for details. Breed Society inspections do not constitute any form of guarantee or warranty. Purchasers should inspect animals themselves to ensure they are suitable, prior to purchase.
Rejected Stock	A quarantine area will be made available, but rejected stock should be removed from the market as soon as possible.
Transportation	All livestock must be transported in vehicles or trailers which comply with the law. There will be washing out facilities at the market, (the cost of which will be included in the commission charges) open from 9-12 on Friday and Saturday. All livestock must travel with the correct passports and licences. If in doubt please contact an Animal Health Officer at your local DEFRA offices.
Animal in transit	Animals in transit and not entered into the event, will be strictly prohibited
Swapping animals in the car park is STRICTLY PROHIBITED and is ILLEGAL.	It could get the market into trouble, and you into serious trouble. Anyone caught will not be permitted to participate in future events. This matter has to be taken very seriously
Hay & Straw	A limited amount of straw will be provided. Vendors must supply their own hay, additional straw and buckets.

General Conditions

- Order of Sale** Animals will be sold strictly in catalogue order (females, then Males in age order) with the exception of breed champions in some breeds. (Please see individual breed information for details). It is the responsibility of the vendor to ensure their animals are presented for sale at the correct time.
- Responsibility** All animals must be penned or stalled in the space allocated. Vendors are solely responsible for and in charge of their stock at all times whilst on the premises.
- Reserve Prices** Any reserve prices must be submitted to the auctioneer **in writing** prior to the sale of any lot.
- Dogs** Dogs will not be permitted in the livestock areas.
- Breed Stands** Each Breed Society will have an area to promote their breed - if space permits this will be in the cattle pens.
